For 20 years the Arts and Business Council of Greater Phoenix has created partnerships between business and the arts that strengthen the arts and business environments in the communities they serve.

- Business Volunteers for the Arts – in 2009 our business volunteers consulted with more than 50 arts organizations on more than 60 projects which translates to their donation of approximately \$300,000.
- Education – In Fiscal Year 2009, we reached arts organizations throughout the state and social service organizations throughout the valley. The National Arts Marketing Project and Management Workshops provided educational opportunities to individuals, from all over the state, in subject areas common to non profit organizations.
- Business on Board – a dynamic program designed to identify, recruit and train business professionals in board governance. Since its inception in 2004, we have graduated more than 150 professionals who have been or are in the process of being matched with arts/cultural and social service organization boards.

### **Arts Organization of the Year**

Recognizes an arts/cultural organization that demonstrates exemplary achievement in fulfilling its mission, community impact and managerial strength. Organizations must be located in Greater Metropolitan Phoenix area and have tax-exempt 501(c)(3) status. (click here for application)

### **Arts Advocate of the Year**

Recognizes a business, civic, community or arts leader who has demonstrated exemplary leadership and support of the arts/cultural community, significantly impacting one or more arts organizations, or the arts community in general. (click here for application)
